Another setback for the climate (/ blow to the climate) from Donald Trump. On Thursday 12 February, the US president announced that he was repealing an official measure aimed at curbing greenhouse gas emissions in the United States. Adopted in 2009 by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the presidency of Democrat Barack Obama / when Democrat B. Obama was president, the measure /the text in question established that six greenhouse gases were harmful to public health and therefore fell within the scope of pollutants regulated by the federal agency.
